We are excited to announce we have a date set for discussion and vision of the expansion project. On Wednesday, **January 27 at 7PM** we will meet, and encourage all interested to attend.

This is an opportunity to bring your questions and strengthen support for this expansion project. The meeting will be a Town Hall / Open House style and it is important we garner attendance from society members, families, staff, alumni, and all stake holders. The idea is to have the gathering in the School Gym. However, because we are unsure what restrictions to public gatherings will look like, there will be an update closer to the date with the potential of having it over Zoom. The evening will provide a better explanation of the vision and discuss the concepts in greater detail.

Topics to be discussed: Layout, Budget, Fine & Industrial Arts, Timeframes, Parking, Existing Upgrades, Ownership.

There are many steps ahead, and none would be possible without the support we've received from Broadview. The design will be agreed upon in conjunction with Broadview and KCS will be required to have funding in place prior to proceeding. KCS has the ability to become a proportional owner of the existing property, based on methods of appraisal deemed fair by both parties prior to construction, something which strengthens our future heritage.
